This past year was a pivotal year in the history of New Beginnings Are Possible. Our outreach to incarcerated youth at St. Charles Place further confirmed our steadfast motto that, "It is easier to build a child than to restore an adult." This belief was the foundation upon which our youth center was built back in 2001. Initially we operated only two days a week, serving 50 youths per day, and offering year-round programming.

What has allowed our efforts to be so successful? In one word...RELATIONSHIPS. This focus is evident in everything we do. We invest in relationships with our staff, providing training and mentoring to deepen their skills. As we build relationships within the community, we find ourselves continually evaluating needs and expanding the services we provide. Part of our three year goal includes improving reading skills among our children and working to ensure all of our students are reading at grade level. Our hopes are also to double our capacity, striving to reach a minimum of 100 youth through our programs and through partnering with outside resources.

While we are proud of our journey from seed, to sprout, to a flourishing ministry, we are not content to rest our laurels. There is still much to be done, and we must look forward rather than backward to reach our set goals. We spend prayerful deliberation constructing a clear, strong vision for the future. Our efforts will be dedicated toward leaning on our wealth of experience to expand operations through our partnerships and friends.



- College tours




WHERE WE'RE GOING ...
